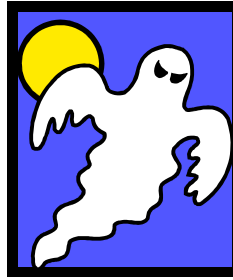


GHOST STORIES
