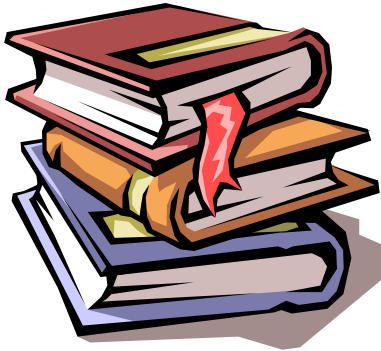

What can the library do for teachers?

- provide library orientation for your students
- collaborate on design and/or implementation of research projects
- collaborate with you / teach your students to:
 - Use research process (Big 6 or other)
 - Create bibliographies / cite resources
 - Determine best materials
 - Use online resources/databases
 - Search the Internet effectively and efficiently
 - Evaluate websites
 - Make / edit films
 - Integrate technology
 - Avoid plagiarism
 - Take notes
 - Identify genres
- pull materials (carts of books, etc) for units
- create *list of websites* (or other resources) for units
 - list available to students via GLMC website
- gather periodical articles to supplement a class topic
- check out videos, books, or periodicals
- assist you in locating, pricing, and ordering books or other materials
- purchase library materials to support your curriculum
- find special items
- support use/provide training for use of *online resources*
- support use of Accelerated Reader/STAR
- support AV equipment
- provide channel for multi-class viewing of video/DVD
- laminate
